

Secondary School Uniform Guidelines

Years 12 & 13 Dress Code

Students are not expected wear the Renaissance College uniform, however, they are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to being in school.

Hair colour must be of a natural colour and style without excessive gel, highlights or extensions.

Make-up should not be worn to excess.

No jewellery is to be worn while participating in physical activity and at other times should be of a subtle nature – large hoop or dangling earrings are not permitted at any time.

Years 7-11

Students are expected to dress in an appropriate manner in the Renaissance College uniform: stripes on outside, mix and match of pieces.

Uniform should fit appropriately – neither too tight nor too baggy. Skirts should not be too short. Undershirts should not extend below the poloshirt.

Hair colour must be natural and styled without excessive gel, highlights or extensions.

Make-up should not be worn in excessive amounts.

Shoes must be predominantly black or brown with black, brown or white laces. During winter, ankle-height boots may be worn.

Socks should be black, brown or white and should not be higher than knee-height. During winter plain black tights or leggings may be worn.

Only RCHK scarves and hats are allowed.

No jewellery is to be worn while participating in physical activity and at other times should be of a subtle nature. Facial piercing is not allowed, other than discreet nose-studs.
