Year 13 Trial Examinations - Jan 2011

Dear Year 13 Students & Parent/Guardian,

1. The Examination & Attendance Requirements

- a. Students should bear in mind that these examinations are for practice, and that they should not be overly stressed or concerned. These exams represent the same importance as internally set assignments they do not form an overall percentage of your semester grade.
- b. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each examination. Students only need to attend school for their actual examination. Students do not need to be in school when they do not have an examination.
- c. Students should arrive at the examination hall 30 minutes prior to the start of each examination. It is the responsibility of the student to make sure they know when and where their exam will be. Any student who arrives 30 minutes after the start of the exam will not be allowed to enter the examination hall.
- d. Students can avail of the library throughout the examination period for revision and silent study.
- e. Students must sign in and sign out at reception, for health and safety reasons.
- f. If illness prevents your attendance to a particular examination, you or your parents are required to phone Ms. Larkin on Ext 513, or Ms Christy Lau on Ext 438, before the start time of the examination.
- g. Students who miss an examination for whatever reason will not be given another opportunity to sit the examination.
- h. Students MUST write their examination paper in pen.

2. The Examination Room

- a. Students are required to bring basic equipment including pens, rulers, grey lead pencils, sharpeners and calculators. Equipment should be kept in a see-through plastic bag, no pencil cases allowed. Your subject teachers will have previously advised students of any specialist equipment required for a particular examination. Simple translating dictionaries are allowed for Groups 3-6 exams if your Language A1 is not English.
- b. No talking or communication, or lending of any equipment, is permitted in the examination room.
- c. Subject teachers may be available at the start of an examination session, but they cannot give any assistance or advice once the examination has started.
- d. Students are not allowed to bring bags or mobile phones into the examination hall. Bags MUST be locked securely in their locker and not left lying outside the examination hall.
- e. Calculators should be cleared of programmes and stored material. Make sure you have backed up of any calculator programmes – your calculator may be cleared during the examination as part of the invigilation process.

3. School Rules

- a. Normal school rules apply for the duration of the examination period.

4. Revision

- a. Please ensure that you create a revision plan and that you revise thoroughly in preparation for each examination.
- b. Your teachers should talk with you about the exams and give you advice and strategies. You should also be told what type of examination you will be given. Please ask your teachers if you are unsure.

I will be available throughout the examination period if students or parents have any concerns or queries.
